The Canadian Open Parkinson Network (also known as C-OPN) is now recruiting people with Parkinson's, a related type of Parkinsonism, or volunteer controls living in Canada to participate in clinical research.

Becoming a C-OPN participant involves completing online questionnaires and one in-person visit. Join over 2000 participants across Canada and contribute to:

C-OPN Database

- Answer questions about yourself, including your lifestyle, medical history, family history, current medications, and symptoms you may or may not experience.
- Complete cognitive testing (MoCA) and motor assessment (MDS-UPDRS). Both of these tests are conducted during the single in-person visit with a C-OPN Coordinator at one of the C-OPN sites.

C-OPN Biobank

- Choose to donate a blood sample during your in-person visit.

C-OPN Registry

- Join the C-OPN Registry and opt to receive email notifications about upcoming local, national, or international research studies seeking participants.
